



NCIC CTG Translational Research Fellowship

The NCIC Clinical Trials Group is accepting applications for the NCIC CTG Translational Research Fellowship.

This position is open to motivated individuals who have completed their oncology or hematology specialty training or PhD in a science discipline from across Canada. The duration of the Fellowship is flexible and may be one or two years in duration.

This Fellowship will be tailored to the background of the incumbent but will include exposure to all aspects of translational research, including the design, conduct and analysis of preclinical and clinical research, with an emphasis on biomarker discovery and validation. The Fellowship is based at the NCIC Clinical Trials Group, but is envisaged that the Fellowship will include substantial exposure to basic science research methods (assay methodology and standardization, handling and processing of biospecimens, conduct of correlative biology studies) as part of a NCIC CTG planned, in progress or completed clinical trial.

This Fellowship is currently funded from an unrestricted Education Grant from OSI Pharmaceuticals. Applicants are encouraged to seek additional grant support. Total salary will be determined by the Canadian Cancer Society Research Institute scales.
