This two-year position is open to motivated individuals who have preferably completed Surgical, Medical or Radiation Oncology training nationally or internationally. The experience will be tailored to the interests of the successful candidate and will establish the fundamentals of a future career as a clinical trialist in an academic setting. Fellows will be actively involved in national and international thoracic oncology clinical trials and learn all aspects of clinical trial conduct, including study design, conduct and analysis. Fellows will play an active role in correlative science aspects of trials and will undertake relevant coursework. Clinical or pharmaceutical industry electives can be included. Interested candidates may also consider a Masters degree at Queens University in a related discipline.
