

2021 Virtual Annual Spring Meeting of Participants Registration Policy

The Annual Spring Meeting of Participants is a **closed** meeting and you must be eligible to attend.

CCTG site committees – Brain, Breast, Gastrointestinal, Genitourinary, Gynecology, Head and Neck, Hematology, Lung, Melanoma, Sarcoma, Supportive Care and the Investigational New Drug (IND) committee – consisting of representatives from member centres meet concurrently over the course of the four-day meeting. In addition, other committees and some working groups will also meet during this time.

All information discussed at the meeting is confidential; therefore, you will need to register and sign a confidentiality agreement. All attendees must register online before they can attend any meetings.

We have a limited number of attendees that can access the Virtual Spring Meeting; therefore, eligibility does not guarantee an invitation. If you would like to be added to our waiting list to receive an invitation please contact meetings@ctg.queensu.ca.

Following is a list of those people eligible to attend:

- ✓ Members of CCTG trial, disease site, or standing committees, and working groups;
- ✓ Staff at any of our participating member centers (investigators, clinical research associates, pharmacists, administrators, etc.);
- ✓ Invitees to “special meetings” being held during the Annual Spring Meeting;
- ✓ Agency staff such as NCI US, Health Protection Branch of Health Canada (HPB), Food and Drug Administration US (FDA), Cancer Therapy Evaluation Program US (CTEP), Clinical Trials Support Unit (CTSU);
- ✓ Other cooperative group members; and,
- ✓ Drug company representatives from those companies who financially support the Annual Spring Meeting or are conducting a trial with the CCTG.

Following is a general list of those people who are not eligible to register or attend:

- ✗ Media representatives;
- ✗ Patients;
- ✗ Company representatives (e.g. drug companies, biotechnology companies, etc.) who do not meet the criteria above;

- ✗ Other individuals who do not meet the “eligible” criteria.
