How Can We Introduce Innovative Treatments into our Publicly-Funded Healthcare System?

Dr. Craig Earle is a medical oncologist at Sunnybrook Health Sciences Centre Odette Cancer Centre in Toronto, Ontario. He is Vice-President of Cancer Control at the Canadian Partnership Against Cancer, a Senior Scientist at the Institute for Clinical Evaluative Sciences, and a Professor of Medicine at the University of Toronto. He is past Chair of the Ontario Steering Committee for Cancer Drug Programs and is a current member of the pan-Canadian Oncology Drug Review Expert Review Committee. His personal research focuses on evaluating and improving the quality of care received by patients with advanced cancer and cancer survivors, the effects of financial incentives on care delivery, and making linked, de-identified administrative data more available for health research.

Dr. Earle originally trained and practiced in Ottawa, after which, beginning in 1998, he spent 10 years in Boston at Harvard Medical School and the Harvard School of Public Health. Between 2008-2017, he was Director of Health Services Research and Head of Clinical Translation at the Ontario Institute for Cancer Research.
